It is hard to believe that we are already planning for the holidays here at Marillac St. Vincent. We are headed into our second Christmas during a pandemic. This has been such a difficult time for everyone. Last year, with your help Christmas Store was alive and well. We are so grateful to your store for your past support for our families on Chicago's West Side. This year we are expecting to provide toys and books to over 250 families, which accounts for upwards of 900 children. **The distribution will be held on Saturday, December 18.** This is a wonderful opportunity for our families to prepare for Christmas.

The families who participate receive a turkey and other groceries that they can use to make a special Christmas dinner. Every family also picks out gifts for each of their children. Last year, due to the generosity of our supporters, we were able to make over 900 children happy with books, toys, sports equipment, and board games to celebrate the holiday.

This year we are asking for new books, games, and toys for children birth-12 years old. The age categories are 0-4 years, 5-8 years, and 9-12 years. Due to the ongoing violence that plagues the communities we serve, we request not to receive any weapon-like toys (Nerf, water guns, action figures wielding weapons etc.).

In order to prepare for the day of distribution, we are asking that we receive donations by no later than Wednesday, December 15. We are more than happy to pick-up donations. Please give advanced notice so we can make sure to schedule a pick-up time that is convenient for you.
